	<b>POS Rules (as system for safe delivery of plant operations</b>	Issue Date: 21/10/14	Author: Steve Milroy

(To be posted on HSQE Notice Boards for a Period of 1 MONTH from date of issue)

1. If you are operating or controlling plant on a Carillion site within 3m of the railway then there must be a POS rep on site
2. The POS Rep is named at the top of the plant pack which must be issued and briefed to each machine operator and controller for each shift
3. The POS Rep is your single point of contact for any plant related issues, and should be in close proximity to the work being carried out.
4. You need to follow the rules, undertake your duties as trained and if in any doubt or have any concerns, **STOP** work and speak to the POS rep
5. If you do not know who your POS rep is or you have not been briefed on the Plant pack then:

**DO NOT WORK.**
