Background

The introduction of long sleeved hi-viz at Carillion was based on a risk assessment and learning from other parts of their business to make their people more visible to plant and vehicles, including on track plant. It has the additional benefit of affording UV protection as well as protecting from splashes, scratches, insects etc.

Specification for PPE taken from Carillion Specialist Contractor Standard document which goes out with all their orders.

If you fail to comply you will be asked to leave site resulting in us losing a shift. Please can you ensure that you always have long sleeve hi-viz clothing to wear at all times.
